

**CALL FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE MOBILITY PROGRAMME - BIP (BLENDED INTENSIVE PROGRAMME) "INTERNATIONAL ARBITRATION MOOT" - ERASMUS+ PROGRAMME FOR STUDENTS OF THE MASTER'S DEGREE IN LAW, ENROLLED IN THE 3<sup>RD</sup>- 4<sup>TH</sup> AND 5<sup>TH</sup> YEAR DURING ACADEMIC YEAR 2024/2025**

## **1. PURPOSE**

The purpose of this call for proposals is to define the conditions under which students of John Paul II Catholic University of Lublin may participate in the BIP (Blended Intensive Program) "International arbitration moot" mobility programme, which is among the novelties of the Erasmus+ Programme, with the aim of combining physical mobility with virtual and distance activities. In this way, students from different European universities receive an educational experience through telematic collaboration between academic institutions, culminating in a short mobility at one of the partner universities. This exchange will be carried out with the aim of academic recognition and achievement, as well as of matching the student's curricular profile. Everything that is not regulated by these terms and conditions will be governed by the European provisions for the Erasmus+ Programme and the General Mobility Regulations of John Paul II Catholic University of Lublin.

## **2. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

The eligibility requirements for student mobility will be the following:

- Being enrolled in 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup> year of the Master's degree in Law at John Paul II Catholic University of Lublin, during the academic year 2024/2025.
- Being a national of one of the countries participating in the Erasmus programme or be recognised by the country in which student resides as a refugee, stateless person or permanent resident.
- Proving knowledge of English at level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR).

## **3. PLACES OFFERED AND DURATION PERIOD OF LENGTH**

**6 places** are offered to participate in the BIP (Blended Intensive Program) "International arbitration moot".

The structure of the programme is attached in Annex I of this call. It is integrated in the academic calendar 2024/2025 as follows:

- 12 weeks of online training between **10<sup>th</sup> January 2025 and 31<sup>st</sup> March 2025**.
- 5 days of face-to-face training at John Paul II Catholic University of Lublin (Poland) from April 21<sup>st</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup>.

## **4. SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS**

Applicants must submit their application by e-mail to [pawel.wrzaszcz@kul.pl](mailto:pawel.wrzaszcz@kul.pl) by **20<sup>th</sup> of December, 2024**. Application received after the deadline may not be taken into consideration. We contact with successful candidates by **January 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2025** and we take into account the possibility of organizing a meeting for additional candidate selection. Candidates who do not wish to participate in BIP project have to send an e-mail to the same address within the above-mentioned deadline.
